You Can Help Fund Faith Formation!

Save your Oleson’s cash register receipts—the community points at the bottom of the receipt add up to dollars for our program. Tom’s Market receipts earn “tomorrow” fund points, but these receipts must be turned in the 15th of the month following each quarter. For example, Jan/Feb/March receipts must be redeemed by April 15th. Any of these receipts turned in after this cannot be redeemed. Please turn in your receipts by January 5th, April 5th, July 5th and October 5th for the previous three months purchases (this allows time to count points and turn them in). Meijer has an even easier program. After registering with them (call the Parish Office for our account number) you can either use a Meijer credit card, cash, or check each time you shop. Meijer keeps track of all points earned each month and we receive a check for the total amount. Campbell soup labels are still gratefully accepted, but now you need save only the UPC code, not the entire label.
